Dear Mr. Stone:

We are pleased to inform you that your proposal for a fiscal year 2011 Small Socially-Disadvantaged Producer Grant (SSDPG) has been selected for funding. This letter establishes conditions which must be understood and agreed to by you before further consideration may be given to your SSDPG application. The State and Area staff of the United States Department of Agriculture, Rural Development, will administer the grant on behalf of the Rural Business-Cooperative Service (RBS).

Through your receipt of federal grant funds, your organization becomes the "recipient" of federal financial assistance. By law, as the recipient of federal assistance your organization becomes responsible for complying with federal civil rights laws in the administration of your programs and activities. It is your responsibility to assure that the beneficiary (i.e., business, cooperative, etc.) has an equal opportunity to apply for and receive the benefit of your programs or services.

The docket may be completed on the basis of a grant not to exceed **\$200,000**. The project must be started by October 1, 2011, and be completed within 365 days, but no later than December 31, 2012. The Agency will not approve requests to extend the grant period.

Please complete and sign the enclosed Form RD 1942-46, "Letter of Intent to Meet Conditions" and Form RD 1940-1, "Request for Obligation of Funds" if you desire that further consideration be given to your application. If the conditions set forth in this letter are not met within 90 days from the day hereof, RBS reserves the right to discontinue the processing of your application.

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR CERTIFICATION

1. By signing and submitting this form, the grantee is providing the certification set out on pages 1 and 2.
2. The certification set out on pages 1 and 2 is a material representation of fact upon which reliance is placed when the agency awards the grant. 

  - (b) As to any personal property acquired or improved with the aid of the Federal financial assistance, so long as Recipient retains ownership or possession of the property.
  - (c) As to any other aided facility or activity, until the last advance of funds under the loan or grant has been made.
4. Upon any breach or violation this agreement the Government may, at its option:
  - (a) Terminate or refuse to render or continue financial assistance for the aid of the property, facility, project, service or activity.
  - (b) Enforce this agreement by suit for specific performance or by any other available remedy under the laws of the United States or the State in which the breach or violation occurs.

Rights and remedies provided for under this agreement shall be cumulative.


