

I want to extend an invitation to those interested in attending the, "Ute Indian Tribe's Annual Buffalo Roundup" the roundup is scheduled for August 28 and 29, 2013. It will be held on the Hill Creek extension of the Uintah and Ouray Reservation, Fort Duchesne, UT.

- The roundup location is 80 miles from Fort Duchesne. The road is rough, dusty, and is known to blow out new tires.
- The first day will be the day we roundup the buffalo via helicopters.
- The second day will be the day we process the buffalo.
- All roundup personnel will camp at buffalo camp for the duration.
- You will need to provide your own sleeping bedding.
- The weather can be: Hot, cold, windy, rainy, and dusty. So prepare accordingly.
- A shuttle will leave from Fort Duchesne at 6:00 A.M. and return daily.

For those planning on attending the following is required prior to your arrival. Please provide this information to me ASAP or no later than COB, Tuesday, August 20, 2013. I need to get an access permit processed for everyone.

1. The name(s) of all in your group.
2. Make, model, state/license number and color of the vehicle you will be driving. (If you plan on driving your personal vehicle to the roundup location).
3. If you are planning on staying at buffalo camp. (This for meal planning purposes).
4. A contact number for your group. (In case there is a change of plans).
